Lighthouse NetCast presenters have the unique and privileged opportunity to represent their Christian faith to the world via the vibrant, friendly and inviting platform of a global internet radio station.

We're not necessarily looking for Bible scholars, former Popes, evangelical crusaders or Archbishops but just ordinary people, living ordinary lives while recognising and acknowledging the extraordinary source of the Grace they have been afforded and is available to us all. Lighthouse NetCast presenters are Christ-centred individuals and are not afraid of speaking up for the message of the Holy Bible.

But, they may also be a drummer in a band, a quarterback, an accountant, a taxi driver, president of the chess club, Scout leader, pilot, ex-Marine, shopkeeper or maybe even a Vicar! A good presenter will relate to the listener by talking about the things that affect us all; e.g. what to do with the kids during holidays, a good movie recently seen at the cinema, how to fry the best chips and how they came to believe in God.

By keeping our faith at the centre of everything we do, but not being over-bearing or forcing it on others, we represent Christianity in a way that is non-threatening and inviting without scaring listeners away.

As the Lighthouse NetCast is a global internet-based radio station, we are not studio-bound. Many of our shows are pre-recorded and uploaded to our broadcast server for future broadcast. Therefore, location is not as important as the gifts and talents you are able to bring to the role.

If you think this sounds like you, read on:

Lighthouse NetCast presenters must:

- have a strong, Christian faith
- speak English and communicate clearly
- be computer literate and comfortable with audio editing software (e.g. Adobe Audition, Audacity etc.)
- be able to follow clear programming direction
- have a good knowledge of popular music (Christian and non-Christian)
- know the difference between an MP3 and WAV file
- be familiar with remote desktop operation and FTP clients
- be organised and capable of working to inflexible deadlines
- be passionate about attention to detail, self-development and delivering compelling material to audiences both small and large

Preferably, Lighthouse NetCast presenters will:

- have some presenting experience (radio or otherwise)
- have worked in a live studio environment
- have access to and an understanding of relatively high-quality recording equipment and editing software
- maintain a varied and extensive set of contacts

There are many more elements we could add to the lists above but the key skills and experience required are covered. Also, we don't want to scare you away!

What we'd initially like from you:

- Covering letter stating why you are interested in this role and what your gifts, talents and experience can bring to the Lighthouse NetCast (no more than 600 words)
- Curriculum Vitae or Résumé
- MP3 demo either presenting live or recorded material
